Happy Independence Day

- Things like firecrackers, rockets, and sparklers are just too dangerous. Sparklers cause more injuries than any other firework each year. They can hurt or kill you.
- Kids should never play with fireworks. Don't allow kids to pick up pieces of fireworks after an event. Some may still be ignited and can explode at any time.
- The best way to protect your family is to not use any fireworks at home. Instead, attend public fireworks displays and leave the lighting to the professionals.
- Think about your pets. Animals have sensitive ears and can be extremely frightened or stressed on the Fourth of July. Keep pets indoors to reduce the risk that they'll run loose or get injured.
- As an additional reminder it is also extremely dangerous and illegal to discharge firearms in celebration. Whatever goes up, comes down and people have been injured and killed.

All fireworks are illegal in Denver. If you get caught with fireworks in Denver, it can cost you a \$999 fine and up to a year in jail. The fireworks will be confiscated.

- **Piense en sus mascotas. Los animales tienen oídos sensibles y pueden estar extremadamente asustados o estresados en el 4 de Julio. Mantenga a las mascotas en interiores para reducir el riesgo de que se escapen o se lesionen.**
- **A modo de recordatorio, además también es extremadamente peligroso e ilegal disparar armas de fuego hacia el cielo en la celebración. Lo que sube baja y gente se ha herido o muerto.**

Los fuegos artificiales son ilegales en Denver. Si lo agarran con fuegos artificiales en Denver puede costarle una multa de \$999 dólares y hasta un año de cárcel. Los fuegos artificiales serán confiscados.

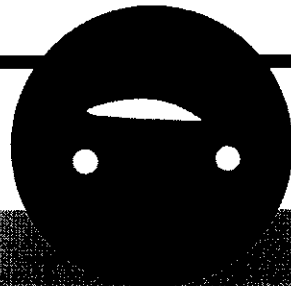

PROTECTING YOUR VEHICLE

The Denver Police Department offers the following tips for protecting your car:



Always lock your car, roll up the windows and take your keys.



Never leave items in your car. All items are valuable to criminals.



Never leave the car unattended even if you are only a few minutes away. Criminals can be very patient and will wait for the right opportunity to steal.



Remove your keys and any items when you get out of your car. Do not leave your keys in the ignition.



Use an alarm system and/or steering wheel lock device so your vehicle is less tempting to steal.



Remove the garage door opener when parked near the house so criminals can't use it to access your house.

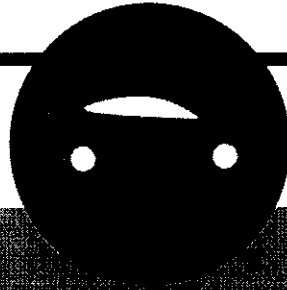

What's going on in your neighborhood?

Building stronger communities through transparency and conversation.

1 **LOG IN OR SIGN UP** to connect with a police officer in your neighborhood, get crime alerts, safety tips and much more.

3 **READ POSTS** from your police officers and find out about events happening in your area.

2 **FOLLOW** as many Denver addresses as you want to get news that matters to you and your family.

4 **COMMENT AND RECEIVE UPDATES** to discuss happenings in your neighborhood with a police officer.

Frequently Asked Questions – FAQ's

Q. Why should I sign up?

- A. First and foremost, **we want to be your neighbor!**
- A. Pocketgov's DPD Virtual Neighborhood is designed to provide you with DPD news that matters to you and your family. You choose what neighborhoods you want to "follow" and you can register multiple addresses. This allows anyone who lives, works or plays in Denver to sign-up and receive customized safety alerts, based on the neighborhoods you follow. On days when we post to the neighborhood(s) you follow, a "Daily Digest" summarizing the post(s) will be emailed to you. The "Daily Digest" synopsis allows you view the posts, without ever having to log in to the mobile-responsive website.
- A. The Virtual Neighborhood is managed by sworn officers. Signing up allows you to comment on posts and have an open, transparent dialogue with the officers.

Q. Is it neighborhood specific?

- A. Yes. When you sign up, you can register multiple addresses and follow multiple neighborhoods. For instance, you might live in Lowry and work in Cherry Creek. The Virtual Neighborhood would allow you to receive customized news for both neighborhoods.

Q. Will I be able to contact my Community Resource Officer?

- A. Yes, the Virtual Neighborhood gives you multiple ways to connect with your Denver Police Community Resource Officer, including email, phone or by simply replying to their post.

Q. Are there restrictions to the neighborhoods I can view?

- A. No, you are free to register as many addresses within the City and County of Denver and "follow" as many neighborhoods as you like. We are committed to transparency and want you to be able to access the information and news that matters to you.

Q. How do I get to Virtual Neighborhood?

- A. Visit www.pocketgov.org from your computer, tablet, or smart phone, then click on "Virtual Neighborhood" to get started.
